

GODWIN CHORAL BOOSTERS MEETING MINUTES -- June 1st , 2009 (as amended)

Iva Keller called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. She recognized Becky Spicer to review proposed minutes of the May meeting . They were approved as printed.

Director's Report: Ms. Matthews asked to report first tonight. Choir Banquet is tomorrow night, June 2nd at 6:00 p.m. We will be recognizing 32 seniors this year, a smaller group than usual. Baccalaureate will be held Sunday June 7th at 3:00 p.m. Seniors need to report at 2:00 and underclassmen at 2:30. Will be singing "For Good" and attendance is mandatory for all choirs. It is for an exam grade for Eagles and Musical Illusions. Once singing is over, underclassmen are free to leave (around 3:20). Show Choir, Accapela and Madrigals sing at graduation June 9th at 7:00 p.m for their exam grade. Busses leave at 5:00 p.m., sound check at Seigel Center at 6:00 p.m., with graduation at 7:00 p.m. This year Henrico County is requiring all chorus underclassmen to stay for entire ceremony. All but graduating seniors must also ride busses home afterward. Should be over around 9:10 p.m. Pleased that so many students auditioned for the Alma Mater this year, and Philip Riley was selected to sing it at graduation. The new quartets will be attending Harmony College the week after school lets out. D. Ray Davis has agreed to chaperone. Next year's calendar will be available Monday June 8th. The Show Choir theme for next year is "Night and Day". Dress code for graduation and baccalaureate will be explained to the students, but for graduation it is skirt and blouse or nice dresses for girls, and suits or sports jackets for boys. Baccalaureate is a little more casual, with shirt and pants for boys, sundresses o.k. for girls.

Treasurer' Report (General Account)—Teresa Lee: Only activity left is the banquet. Please bring any reimbursement receipts to Teresa tomorrow night or ASAP so the budget can be closed out by end of the month. We made \$203.05 at the used book sale and \$268 on Franco's casseroles.

Treasurer's Report (Spring Trip)— Candace Branch: Still working on getting those final payments from some students.

Membership -- Linda Reckenbeil : Got two new memberships, plus over \$200 in decal money. Receipts given to Teresa Lee. AMENDED TO READ: Turned in \$190 to the Treasurer, representing \$55 in decal money and \$135 in membership.

Ways and Means – Linda Bendheim (unable to attend): Thanks given to Kim Davis for getting folks to chair many of the fundraising activities for next year. This allows Linda to oversee the fundraisers rather than do them herself or recruit others .

Concert Flowers – Allison Revenson and Julia Bard (unable to attend): No report given

Banquet – Martha-Gray Colver : A few changes this year in order to speed up the event. First there will be no name tag/check in/ registration this year. Donna Llewellyn will man a small registration table for walk- in's and for those not sure they paid. This will avoid lines. Also, the seniors will serve themselves rather than students or parents. Still trying to get the Senior memory book together, plus need volunteers to help clean up. Have plenty to help set up. Need to discuss the process of a booster gift for Ms. Matthews with the President and Executive Committee after the meeting. Should be a fun night, with about 245 signed up to attend.

Other Business—Iva Keller: At the Banquet every year we have seniors put together scrapbook size posters of themselves for display. We have borrowed different display boards over the years, but might like to purchase some. Teresa Lee and others agreed to check into some options and costs. Storage of them might also be an issue. Two possible new fundraisers have surfaced. One is through Pizza Hut, the selling of Pizza Coupon Cards for \$10 each, with a return of \$6 per card. Will check into it further and consider it for next spring. Iva also raised the possibility of a touring band concert, with all entrance fee proceeds going to the Boosters. Iva will check into this further.
